Beacon CEO joins BC Care Providers Board

VICTORIA, BC – Beacon Community Services' CEO Bob Boulter was today elected to the board of the BC Care Providers Association (BCCPA). The election was held at BCCPA's Annual General Meeting in Whistler BC.

Established 37 years ago, BCCPA is the leading industry association representing service providers in British Columbia's continuing care sector, including non-profit and private care providers from the residential care, assisted living, and home care services sectors. The Association's membership base includes over 130 residential care, assisted living and home care members, as well as over 135 commercial members.

A Chartered Accountant who holds a degree in Business Administration from the University of Regina, Boulter has served as CEO of Victoria-based charity Beacon Community Services since August 2014.

Established on the Saanich Peninsula in 1974, Beacon Community Services has evolved to become one of BC's largest non-profit social services organizations and – as the agency contracted to serve as the Island Health Authority's sole provider of home support services on southern Vancouver Island – is one of Western Canada's largest home support providers. The organization serves more than 6,000 clients in the Greater Victoria region, including through programs and services in: Child, Youth and Family Services; Counselling and Mental Health Services; Employment and Training Programs; Housing, Assisted Living and Licenced Dementia Housing; Adult/Senior's Recreation Services; Volunteer Services; and Home Support Care.
