

## **Precariously Employed**

For the Program, a Precariously Employed Person means an individual who does not meet the Program definition of Unemployed, but who meets at least one of the following criteria:

1. The working poor who:
  - A. Are working in unstable or unsustainable employment (including self-employment) as evidenced by:
    - i. irregular hours of work (such as casual labour or on-call work); and/or
    - ii. unreliable remuneration (such as piece-work or commission); and
    - iii. earnings that cannot support an individual or their family; or
  - B. Are working, but whose total employment (including self-employment) income is below the market basket measures;
2. And/or an individual who:
  - A. Is working in an industry or occupation that is likely to be replaced by technology or automation in the near future; or
  - B. Is working in an occupation or profession that is clearly lower than their skills or qualifications and that provides no imminent prospect of advancement; or
  - C. Could have just cause for leaving their current employment.
