The goal of the Better at Home program is to provide non-medical services to support seniors living in their own homes for as long as possible. The Housekeeper is an integral part of the Better at Home team providing light housekeeping services to seniors. The Housekeeper will report to the Better at Home Coordinator.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide light housekeeping services to seniors who are living independently in their own homes.
- Services may include:
 - Vacuuming and mopping floors
 - Kitchen floors, counters, sink
 - Bathroom sinks, tubs, showers, counters, toilets, floors
 - Making beds or changing bed linens
 - Laundry
 - Cleaning windows
 - Cleaning out refrigerator
 - Dusting
- Visits are 1-2 hours.
- Follow schedule as provided by Better at Home Coordinator.
- Call clients the day before appointment.
- Follow check in and check out protocol.
- General knowledge of Beacon Community Services.
- All other duties as required.
