ANNOUNCEMENT OF FUTURE CEO TRANSITION

VICTORIA BC – Beacon Community Services CEO Bob Boulter has advised the charity’s Board of Directors of his intention to step down from his position, after a long and successful career that included more than a decade with Beacon. Boulter’s departure is planned to take place over the coming months, not immediately.

He will remain CEO until a successor is in place, continuing to lead the organization of 250 employees and 600 volunteers and ensuring a smooth transition.

With great sadness and regret, the Board accepted his decision and has initiated a process to determine his successor.

“Bob has served Beacon and our community exceptionally well and his leadership has provided a very solid foundation for continued success as we work to help people and improve lives in our community,” said Board Chair Carla Robinson.

“We appreciate that we will continue to benefit from his guidance, expertise and support while we look to fill his position in the coming months, and plan for the next era of Beacon.”
